Saturday

Grouped Class 1 to include:

- (1) Agility (Combined Grades 1-3)
- (2) Jumping (Combined Grades 1-3)
- (3) Steeplechase (Combined Grades 1-3)

Grouped Class 2 to include:

- (4) Agility (Combined Grades 4-7)
- (5) Jumping (Combined Grades 4-7)
- (6) Steeplechase (Combined Grades 4-7)

Sunday

Grouped Class 3 to include:

- (7) Agility (Combined Grades 1-3)
- (8) Jumping (Combined Grades 1-3)
- (9) Steeplechase (Combined Grades 1-3)

Grouped Class 4 to include:

- (10) Agility (Combined Grades 4-7)
- (11) Jumping (Combined Grades 4-7)
- (12) Steeplechase (Combined Grades 4-7)

When entering online you will see Grouped Class to enter (e.g. class 1) this will enter you into all three of the eligible separate classes for that day (1, 2, & 3), we will send your running orders back with the three classes listed separately.

Classes 1, 2, 3, 7, 8, 9 are open to dogs in KC grades 1-3
Classes 4, 5, 6, 10, 11, 12 are open to dogs in KC grades 4-7

Each class is open to Large, Intermediate, Medium & Small dogs.

The course for each class will be the same for all heights.

NFC/Training runs will be allowed (max 60 seconds), a silent toy may be used but no food/treats.

Each group will be able to course walk & run each class.

Full details of time slots and group information will be made available with your running orders.

Dog & Jump Heights

Large:	For dogs measuring over 500mm at the withers. Jump height 600mm
Intermediate:	For dogs measuring over 430mm and measuring 500mm or under at the withers. Jump height 500mm
Medium:	For dogs measuring over 350mm and measuring 430mm or under at the withers. Jump height 400mm
Small:	For dogs measuring 350mm or under at the withers. Jump height 300mm

Dogs do not need to be officially registered or measured but must have received appropriate agility training and be able to negotiate all equipment in a safe manner.

Awards

Trophies/Medals: In each class/height.

Placed Rosettes: To at least 10% of the class/height.

Clear Round Rosettes: In all classes.

Results will be combined by grade and split by height in all classes.

Rosettes & Awards will be posted out after the show.

Please Note

- Please park where directed and follow the directions of the parking stewards.
- There will be a small exercise area available, and public footpaths around the fields a short distance from the site.
- No camping will be available.
- If you would like to be in the same group as friends, please indicate this when entering the show and we will do our best to group you together.
- Running orders, show info etc will not be posted out, they will be available to download/print from www.showtime-online.co.uk

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Dogs entered at this show must have received appropriate agility training and be able to negotiate all equipment in a safe manner.
2. Entry fees £16.50 for three eligible classes.
3. JDA DTC reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
4. Dogs under 18 calendar months of age on the day of the Show are not eligible to compete.
5. Dogs aged under four calendar months may attend the show 'not for competition', but are not permitted ringside.
6. No bitch in season or pregnant bitch is allowed to compete.
7. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time.
8. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead, harness or muzzle when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar i.e. not attached by a ring.
9. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the Judge or Judges.
10. Hurdle Heights: Large 600mm, Intermediate 500mm, Medium 400mm, Small 300mm.
11. A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from an Agility Show if it is:-
 - a. A bitch which is in season.
 - b. Suffering from any infectious diseases or contagious disease.
 - c. Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
 - d. Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
 - e. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
12. In the event that the show is cancelled, JDA DTC will refund fees, less any incurred expenses, within one calendar month of the day of the show.
13. Food shall not be allowed in the ring, in hand or pockets. Bumbags, treatbags, training aids or toys are also not allowed in the ring (a silent toy may be used for NFC/Training runs).
14. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to ensure their dog is 'fit for function' and that they themselves are fit to take part. By accepting the declaration you confirm that to the best of your knowledge your dog is fit and able to take part in Agility classes on the day of the show.
15. No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the Competition may attend the show.
16. It is the competitors' responsibility to be available for their class and running order. Full details of time slots and group information will be made available with your running orders.
17. Any handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove as soon as possible any fouling caused by their dog(s); failure to do so may result in removal from the show.
18. If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.
19. All dogs are entered at this show at their owners risk and whilst every care will be taken, the management of the show will not accept responsibility for loss, damage or injury however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the show.
20. JDA DTC reserve the right to limit or close entries before the published closing date if necessary.
21. JDA DTC or their authorised agents may make results from this show publicly available and share results with third parties for the same purpose.
22. Refunds will not be given after the show closing date unless the show is cancelled.
23. Children are the responsibility of a Parent or Guardian and must be supervised at all times.
24. By entering this show you agree to abide by government and local authority guidance regarding Covid-19 and social distancing in force at the time of the show.
