SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

- This is a “fun” show! Please don’t take yourself too seriously. Have fun – we will be!
- All dogs from the age of 16 calendar months with reasonable competence on agility equipment are eligible to compete at this Fun Show.
- All dogs will compete at their single chosen height, over the same course. The results will NOT be split for the different dog sizes.
- Each course will be walked at the beginning of the class by all heights.
- Class 7 ‘Judge’s Choice’ will be chosen by each judge, and a reminder of the rules will be given while walking the course.
- Timing will be done electronically, in the event of timing failure a re-run will be offered. Manual timing may be used should the electronic timing fail.
- 1st place in each class wins a prize, and places given are 1st-5th in all classes (rosettes will be split 1st-5th combined 1-3 and 1st-5th combined 4-7).
- Toys are permitted in the ring.
- Food is permitted but MUST NOT be crumbly or easily dropped as this would distract other dogs. If food is being carried it must be in a sealed pocket or pouch.
- Training aids such as stride regulators and food dispensing equipment are permitted.
- The use of any training aid or toy makes your run not for competition.
- A bed, mat or restrain at the start is permitted.
- Bitches in Season are allowed to compete but must start from a Mat or towel that it is your responsibility to provide.
- All dogs are entered at the owner’s risk. Whilst every care will be taken, the show organisers will not take responsibility for the loss, damage, or injury to dogs, persons, or property whilst at the show.
- This is a working livery yard, please respect the people and horses on the yard.
- Please pick up ALL dog mess and dispose of it in the bags/bins provided.
- Dogs must be kept on leads at all times in the car parking area, the onsite walks and in the indoor school, except whilst in the ring.
- In the unlikely event that the competition has to be cancelled, we reserve the right to deduct unrecoverable expenses incurred before returning entry fees.

BEST CLUB/TRAINER TROPHY



Our very own club mascot Kady (Orcadian Knight) sadly passed over to rainbow bridge on 7th January 2020., aged 13 years. Kady was a one in a million dog. Reaching Grade 7 in 2009, at just 3 years of age and competing for Scotland at the World Agility Championships (WAO - the most prestigious event in the world) 4 years in a row, taking Laura to England, Belgium, Spain and Italy, gaining a bronze and silver medal for Scotland. He fathered 3 amazing litters of which Titch, Pepper, Mike, Tam, Glen and Nesta were born and not to mention his very last 'accident' which produced Bing and Cassie.

Also not forgetting Edge and Eva who were taken to rainbow bridge far too soon, at a young age. To celebrate Kady's wonderful life we are introducing a best Club (i.e. Devana Dogs) / Trainer (i.e. Joe Bloggs) trophy and this will be presented at the end of each winter series to the nominated person of the winning club / trainer. It will be your responsibility to add your club / trainer to your entry form and points will be accumulated after each show.

Points from 1st-10th place in each class will be collected throughout the shows and the handler and dog from combined 1-3 and combined 4-7 with the most points accumulated over the winter shows will be awarded the trophies. These are perpetual trophies and must be returned the following winter.

DIRECTIONS

FROM THE NORTH (A96)

From A96 Huntly - Go down A96 as far as Old Rayne where you will turn left towards Old Rayne, take the 2nd RD on the right, Strathorn Rd, carry on down here for approximately 1 mile, the farm is on your right, take the 2nd entrance to the farm.

FROM ABERDEEN

Take the A96 north towards Inverurie Stay on here until the Old Rayne, where you will turn right, take the 2nd RD on the right, Strathorn Rd, carry on down here for approximately 1 mile, the farm is on your right, take the 2nd entrance to the farm.

FROM THE SOUTH (A90)

Take the A90 towards Aberdeen, at Stonehaven Take the A90 AWPR road for Aberdeen North. Stay on here till A96 North towards Inverurie Stay on here until the Old Rayne, where you will turn right, take the 2nd RD on the right, Strathorn Rd, carry on down here for approximately 1 mile, the farm is on your right, take the 2nd entrance to the farm.
