Information about selection process

Due to the growing popularity of this event, we now annually run a selection process for members of the IMCA team.

Our international judge for this year's event is **ANJA DIELS** from Belgium. Anja is a highly respected international judge who has also agreed to be one of our Championship Judges at the UK Championships in 2026.

There will be two courses of Agility and one jumping course on Saturday and one Agility and one Jumping course on Sunday. Once again, this year, to be eligible for consideration to the team, competitors will be required to attend **BOTH** days. To make selection fair to everyone and gives everyone more opportunities to show us what you and your dog can do!

Handler and dog combinations will be assessed and may be discussed with some of our regular PAWC team helpers in attendance. The team selection will **NOT** solely be based on the days achievements but may include other factors such as:

- Handlers experience (International, championship classes or grade of classes handled in)
- Dog's experience (International, championship classes or grade of classes competed in)
- Speed of dog / handler combination over courses (ie meters per second)
- Achievements from any previous championships with same dog/handler combinations
- Touch point accuracy
- Dogs & Jump heights will be the same as the UK Kennel Club Regulations again this year.
- Dogs have to have been officially measured and hold a recorded height in their measurement book.
- There will be NO "on spot win" team places allocated as potential team members may also be viewed at several shows or online runs before final decisions and invitations are made.
- If there are two or more people who are felt to be of equal standing in the selection process the choice will be given to the person that performed the better in the 2025 try outs or has supported, attended and achieved in previous year's championship competitions.
- All Team Members are self-funding so this must be a consideration to take into account if you are interested in joining the team. Competing internationally is not cheap on the pocket – even though it is in the UK in 2026! Individual entries for the 2026 will be £85 per dog in the individual championship and £30 per dog in the team events. There will be camping available on site or hotels will be listed on our new web page due soon.
- As a team, we try and raise enough funds to cover some of the team costs each year thus reducing individuals costs, but again this will depend on our annual fund raising success.
- It is the intention Team member invites will be made by the end of April.
- **Please note we would like team members a day or so early to help set up and take down on the Sunday evening / Monday morning. For any team members arriving early to help and are camping no camping fee will be charged on the Monday or Tuesday nights before the championship commences.**

There will be lovely rosettes and goodies awarded.
