Class	Description	Grades
1	Starters jumping - jumps, tunnels, weaves	1-2
2	Jumping - jumps, tunnels, weaves	3-5
3	Jumping - jumps, tunnels, weaves	6-7
4	Tunnel Exchange – jumps and tunnels only 1 dog, 2 handlers <i>Sponsored by Track & Trail Canine Outfitters</i>	1-7
5	Pairs Helter Skelter – jumps and tunnels only 2 dogs, 2 handlers <i>Sponsored by Cydymaith Dog Training</i>	1-7
6	Starters Steeplechase - jumps and tunnels only	1-2
7	Steeplechase - jumps and tunnels only	3-5
8	Steeplechase - jumps and tunnels only	6-7
9	Grand National (This class will be a Pay on the day, time permitting) - <u>a simple circular course run at small height for all dogs</u>	

All classes are open to all heights. Depending on entry numbers results & prizes will be split by height (S-M & I-L) and classes 4 and 5 will be split by grades (1-3 & 4-7).

Rules:

This show is not affiliated to any other organisation and dogs do not need to be KC registered to enter

1. Dogs must be 18 months old on the day of the show to compete.
2. Please let the judge know if you would like your run to be NFC
3. Grade – please enter at your Kennel Club grade. If you and your dog have never competed before you should enter grade 1
4. Dogs should be entered in their measured KC height or the height that the owner/handler believes is closest to their actual height. Dogs can jump at any height. Jump heights will be set as follows: Large 60cm, Intermediate 50cm, Medium 40cm, Small 30cm and Micro 20cm. You can decide on the day.
5. Rosettes – places will be given to approximately 10% in each class with awards split according to height and grades where appropriate. Judges will also present a number of special awards. Clear round rosettes will be given to all dogs with unplaced clear round.

6. All grades and heights will run the same course for each class. Each class will start with Large and run down through the jump heights, finishing with micro. All handlers will walk the course at the same time, regardless of which height they are running.
7. Marking of your run will follow standard Kennel Club marking.
8. You may take toys into the ring. You may reward your dog on the start line with food or toys. Once you have started, please do not use treats in the ring. If you use a toy during your dog's run, you will be eliminated.
9. If you intend to use your run purely as a training round, then you may be asked to leave after you have used up the course time.
10. If your dog toilets in the ring, you must leave once you have cleaned up after your dog. Site rules apply, please see boards at venue.
11. Dogs that have suffered from an infectious disease or have been in contact with a dog suffering from an infectious disease, in the 21 days before the show, may not attend the show or be brought to the venue.
12. Bitches in season may attend this event
13. Results will be made publicly available and can be viewed at www.showtimeonline.co.uk. Competitors are advised that the show organisers or their authorised agents may make results from this show publicly available and share results with third parties for the same purpose.

Directions

The venue is five miles from Dumfries. Follow signs for *Dashing Dogs Academy*. It's located at **Greenmerse Farm, DG2 8EY**. Event signage will guide you from the main road.

From the **A75**, at the Gardenwise roundabout head for Dumfries A780 (first exit if coming from the east, second exit if coming from the west). After 1 mile turn sharp right onto the A710, New Abbey Road. In 3 miles look for event signs near the **Greenmerse Farm turn-off**, on the left, before you get to Mabie Forest.
