Awards

Rosettes will be awarded for first to third place in each class. Prizes for first place in all classes.

Results and prizes for standard classes will be split by the following height categories: combined Large and Intermediate, combined Medium, Small and Micro. Results for anysize and veteran classes will be combined and combined for all heights.

Rules:

This show is not affiliated to any other organisation and dogs do not need to be Royal Kennel Club (RKC) registered to enter.

1. Dogs must be 18 months old on the day of the show to compete.
2. Please let the judge know if you would like your run to be (Not For Competition) NFC.
3. Grade – please enter at your RKC grade. If you and your dog have never competed before you should enter grade 1.
4. Dogs should be entered in their measured RKC height. Jump heights will be set as follows: Large 600mm, Intermediate 500mm, Medium 400mm, Small 300mm and Micro 200mm.
5. Rosettes – places will be given to third place in each class with awards split according to height and grades where appropriate.
6. All heights will run the same course for each class. All handlers will walk the course at the same time, regardless of which height they are running.
7. Veteran classes are open to dogs eight years old or over on the day of the show. Jumps will be set at 500mm, 400mm, 300mm or 200mm. Handlers may chose which height they wish to compete at. Dog's entered as veteran may not enter any other classes at the show apart from anysize/veteran classes.
8. Anysize classes are open to dogs not entered in any other classes at the show apart from anysize/veteran classes. Jumps will be set at 500mm, 400mm, 300mm or 200mm. Handlers may chose which height they wish to compete at.
9. Marking of your run will follow standard RKC marking.
10. You may take toys into the ring. If you use a toy during your dog's run, the run will be marked NFC.
11. If you intend to use your run purely as a training round, then you may be asked to leave after you have used up the course time.
12. If your dog toilets in the ring, you must leave once you have cleaned up after your dog. Please clean up after your dog in all of the shoe precincts and surrounding areas.
13. Dogs that have suffered from an infectious disease or have been in contact with a dog suffering from an infectious disease, in the 21 days before the show, may not attend the show or be brought to the venue.
14. Bitches in season may attend this event.
15. Results will be made publicly available and can be viewed at www.showtimeonline.co.uk.

Directions:

From the M74/M6 junction 22 – head west on the A75 towards Annan, turn left at the signs for Eastriggs.

From Dumfries and the west – head east on the A75, turn right at the signs for Eastriggs.
