Special Events Ring

There will be special classes each weekday in this ring, weather/time permitting.

Classes will be announced each morning and entries will be taken at the show.

Classes may include:

- Power and Speed
- Standard Pairs
 - Brace Pairs
 - TFO Agility
- Tunnel Exchange
- Down and out

There will be a trophy for the winner of each fun class and Rosettes will be awarded.

Tunnel Exchange

1 dog and 2 handlers. A flowing jumping course with jumps and tunnels. Handlers exchange at the tunnel at around the half way point.

Power & Speed-

The goal of this game is to test the dog's versatility on a course designed in two parts. The first part is the power section followed by the second part, the speed section. The power section is made up of the three pieces of contact equipment, one long jump, one spread jump and one set of 12 weave poles. The judge may decrease the maximum spread length due to unsatisfactory weather and ground conditions. A standard course time (SCT) for the power section will be set by the judge. The time will start as the dog attempts Number 1 and will stop before the dog starts the speed section. Therefore if the dog has not completed the power section within the power section course time, the dog will not be able to run the speed section. Judge or scribe will indicate game over by shouting "time" or by blowing a whistle. The speed section will be made up with a maximum of 14 obstacles, jumps and tunnels, (excluding the tyre, spreads and long jump). The speed section's course time will be determined using the standard course time matrix. The dog may be handled between the power section and the speed section. Although, the dog may not be handled between the power obstacles. If dogs are faulted on the power section, this will be marked as an elimination. The handler and dog may finish the power section but may not continue onto the speed section.

Large/Intermediate Pairs Jumping – Pairs to consist of any combination of dogs. Jump height will be set at Intermediate. All entries MUST consist of complete pairs.

Medium/Small Pairs Jumping – Pairs to consist of any combination of dogs. Dogs will all jump Small height. All entries MUST consist of complete pairs.

Time, Fault and Out Agility - This class will contain Contact obstacles. Dogs will compete over a numbered course within a set time period. The judge will shout Fault/Time when either a fault is incurred, or the time set by the judge is reached. Dogs must then negotiate the finish obstacle to stop the electronic timing. The winner will be the dog that completes the most obstacles in the fastest time. Obstacles taken after the whistle has blown will not be included in the dogs score.

Down & Out Jumping -This class will NOT contain Contact obstacles. Dogs will compete over a numbered course within a set time period. The judge will shout Fault/Time when either a fault is incurred or the time set by the judge is reached. Dogs must then negotiate the finish obstacle to stop the electronic timing. The winner will be the dog that completes the most obstacles in the fastest time. Obstacles taken after the whistle has blown will not be included in the dogs score.

Brace Pairs – 2 dogs - 1 handler

Large/Intermediate (any combination) will run intermediate jump height.

Medium /Small (any combination) will run small jump height

ELIGIBILITY FOR CLASSES

In the following definitions of classes First Prizes or other prize wins are those gained in standard classes at any Kennel Club licensed Championship Agility, Premier Agility, Open Agility or Limited Agility Shows (i.e. special classes and invitational events excepted). Only a first place with a clear round completed within the course time set by the judge will count towards grade progression.

Standard classes may be scheduled for Agility Shows, as Agility classes or Jumping classes. All standard classes must contain the Weaving Poles obstacle. Standard Agility classes must contain the following elements: "A Ramp", Dog Walk and See-Saw. With this proviso classes are defined as follows: -

A maximum of four standard classes may be scheduled for any dog on an individual day of competition. Any number of special classes may be scheduled.

Class Structure. A Class may either be held as a Graded Class or a Combined Class. A Graded Class may be scheduled for **a maximum of three** consecutive Grades with separate results and awards issued for each grade. A Combined Class may be scheduled for more than one consecutive grade with one overall set of results.

A class will be won by the dog that has completed the course in the fastest time with the least number of faults, unless otherwise stated for special classes.

Progression. Progression from each Grade will be determined by the eligibility for the class as referenced in H(1)(A)11. Results from Combined Classes will only count towards progression from the dog's current grade. To count for progression wins must be gained in standard classes at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows. Only a first place with a clear round completed within the course time set by the judge will count towards grade progression.

Competitors will be allowed to walk the course set at Small, Medium, Intermediate or Large height without their dog(s) before the class begins.

Points Progression. At the handler's discretion a dog may progress up to Grade 4 by winning 100 points at each grade, using the Agility Warrant points scheme (Regulation K3.c refers). **A minimum of 50 points must be gained in agility (not jumping) classes in the relevant grade.** If this method of progression is selected, the handler must ensure the Show Secretary signs the dog's Agility Record Book at the first show entered at the higher grade. There is no time limit on this progression, however once a dog has progressed, it cannot return to a previous grade.

Progression on points must be done prior to the closing date of entries. It is not possible to change a grade on points once the entries have closed.

Standard Classes

Only first prizes and points gained in standard classes at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows may be used for progression through the classes. (A dog is only eligible for one grade). In defining the eligibility of the owner or handler for Grade 1, the **two** wins and points progression referred to in the definition apply only to one dog and not an accumulation of dogs.

Grade 1

Open to owners, handlers or dogs which have not gained a minimum of two first places at Grade 1 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, at least one of which must have been gained in an agility (not jumping) class. N.B Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1 are not eligible for this class.

Grade 2

Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 1 and are not eligible for Grades 3, 4, 5, 6, or 7.

Grade 3

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of two first places at Grade 2 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, one of which must have been gained in an agility (not jumping) class or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 and are not eligible for Grades 2, 4, 5, 6 or 7.

Grade 4

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of three first places at Grade 3 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, two of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping classes), or have elected to progress on points from Grade 3 and are not eligible for Grades 2, 3, 5, 6 or 7.

Grade 5

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of four first places at Grade 4 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, two of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping) classes, and are not eligible for Grades 2, 3, 4, 6 or 7.

Grade 6

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of four first places at Grade 5 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, three of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping) classes, and are not eligible for Grades 2, 3, 4, 5 or 7.

Grade 7

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of five first places at Grade 6 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, three of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping) classes, and are not eligible for Grades 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6.

SPECIAL CLASSES

Societies may schedule classes other than those defined above as "Special classes". The eligibility for "Special" classes must be defined by the Society and included in the schedule. The word "Special" must be included in the title of the class. Where special classes are classified for older and/or inexperienced dogs, the height of the hurdles the A-ramp, and the dog walk and the length of the long jump, may be reduced below the dimensions specified in these regulations, in which case such dimensions must be included in the class definition in the show schedule.

Marking for special classes may deviate from marking for standard classes but must be specified in the schedule.

Wins, places and clear rounds in special classes will not count towards agility warrant points or grade progression at Kennel Club shows.

Measuring of Dogs - Competitors are reminded that all dogs must have been officially measured before competing at a Kennel Club licensed agility show. Record books or proof of measurement must be available on request.

Special Steeplechase

A flowing jumping course that will contain jumps and tunnels only. The course time will be 60 seconds. Results will be separate for each of the heights. Jump heights will be Large, Intermediate, Medium Small and Micro. Dogs will run at their measured height except Veteran and Anysize dogs who will run at Micro (250mm) and entered in at least one other Veteran/Anysize class that day.

Special Helter-Skelter

A flowing jumping course that will contain jumps and tunnels only. The course time will be 60 seconds. Results will be separate for each of the heights. Jump heights will be Large, Intermediate, Medium Small and Micro. Dogs will run at their measured height except Veteran and Anysize dogs who will run at Micro (250mm) and entered in at least one other Veteran/Anysize class that day.

Special Anysize/Veteran Jumping & Agility

Open to dogs not entered in any other classes at the show except Steeplechase and Helter-Skelter. Veterans must be 8 years or over on the day of the show. The Agility class will contain an A-Frame and dog walk set at a lower height. There will be no seesaw, weaves long jump or tyre. Jump heights will be 400mm for Large and Intermediate dogs, 300mm for medium dogs and 250mm for small dogs. The course will be simple and flowing and have a course time of 60 seconds. Results will be separate for each height.

Special Border Collie Jumping

Open to Border collies, working sheepdogs and their crosses.

Special ABC Jumping

Open to all breeds except Border collies, working sheepdogs and their crosses.

INFORMATION - PLEASE READ!!!

The precincts of the show include the camping area, day parking, competition rings and exercise area.

Kennel Club regulations apply to all these areas.

Dogs are to be kept on lead at all times except when competing and in the exercise area; only 2 dogs per handler may be off lead at any time.

No cages/crates to be left within the proximity of the entrance/exit of the ring this includes the score tents or by prior arrangement with the show manager.

Walking - All heights will walk the course once it is set up, then 5 minutes between heights.

SPEED LIMIT: 5 MPH on venue at all times

Camping

Camping is available for 5 nights from 2.00pm Thursday 24th September until Monday 28th September (Venue to be vacated by 10.30 Tuesday 29th September)

Fees – Block (5 nights) £75 or £16.50 per night

No arrivals before 2pm on first day/night of camping.

Anyone arriving before this time will not be allowed to pitch.

Judges will receive 2 nights free camping, Scribes 1 free night. Please claim on entry.

Pitches will **not be** allocated. You can save one space only

There is a £1.50 Facilities charge per day for those NOT camping.

Rules & Regulations

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B or else registration or transfer of registration must have been applied for. The Registration number/Authority to Compete number will be required for each entry.
2. All dogs registered and resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the Show/event can be made. All overseas entries without a Kennel Club Registration or an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
3. FEES. Single class entries - £5.45 There is no charge for NFC entries. Facilities charge £1.50 for non-campers.
4. PRIZE MONEY. There will be no prize money at this show.
5. Internet entries will be accepted via www.Showtime-online.co.uk
6. The Committee reserves itself the right to refuse entries.
7. Only dogs of 18 calendar months and over on the day of competition are eligible for competition at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows.
8. A dog must not compete in the same class more than once, including special classes.
9. Not for Competition (NFC) entries will be accepted for dogs, aged 12 weeks and over. Dogs must be Kennel Club registered with their details recorded on the entry form.
10. A bitch which is in season is allowed to attend a show providing it is kept away from the competition areas. Except those dogs that are attending the show to compete in quarter-finals, semi-finals and finals of Royal Kennel Club Prestige Events, other than events held under YKC rules, who are allowed to compete in these classes only. Qualified handlers are asked to remove their dog from the competition area as soon as they have competed in the Prestige Event.
11. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the competitions is forbidden.
12. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show.
13. Dogs must not wear any type of slip or half-slip collar or lead when under test. A single flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar, i.e. not attached by a ring.
14. Should a judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
15. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges.
16. Sponsors – Skinners Pet Foods
17. Not Applicable
18. Kennel Club Standard marking Regulations apply.
19. Veteran and Any Size classes:
 - Large/Intermediate dogs to jump 400mm
 - Medium dogs to jump 300mm
 - Small dogs to jump 250mm
20. Height limits for dogs:
 - Large dog classes – For dogs measuring over 500 mm at the withers.
 - Intermediate dog classes – For dogs measuring over 430mm and measuring 500mm or under at the withers.
 - Medium - for dogs measuring over 350mm and measuring 430mm or under at the withers
 - Small - for dogs measuring 350mm or under at the withers
21. Judges at an agility show may not judge a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership; or handle a dog at the show at which they are judging. Dogs may be disqualified if proved to have been handled in the class by the scheduled judge's spouse or immediate family, or resident at the same address as the scheduled judge.
22. Removal of dogs from Competition:
Following discussion between the show management and/or a veterinary surgeon a dog shall be prevented from competing and/or removed from the Show if it is:-
 - a. A bitch which is in season (apart from dogs attending the show to compete in quarter finals, semi-finals and finals of Kennel Club Prestige Events, other than events held under YKC rules).
 - b. Suffering from any infectious diseases or contagious disease.
 - c. Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
 - d. Of such temperament or is so much out of control as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
 - e. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
 The circumstances of such a removal shall be recorded in the competition/show Incident Book and submitted to the Royal Kennel Club.
23. Removal of Competitors: No equipment shall be moved without permission of the judge. Any concerns regarding the course shall be discussed with the judge/show management. Any unauthorised movement of equipment may result in removal of the competitor from the show. All such removals should be reported to The Royal Kennel Club in the Incident Book.
24. Dog Agility is a competitive and physically strenuous activity. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to ensure their dog is 'fit for function' and that they themselves are fit to take part. By signing the entry form you confirm that to the best of your knowledge your dog is fit and able to take part in Agility classes on the day of the show.
25. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to & including 18 days before the start of the competition i.e. **7th September 2026** shall be counted when entering for any class. For these purposes a competition shall be defined as all classes covered within the same schedule. In the event that a dog becomes eligible for the next grade at a particular show, after the entry for that show has been sent, it is the competitor's responsibility to notify the show secretary **at least 14 days before the date of the show (11th September 2026)**. The dog will then be moved into the appropriate class(es) for the next grade. The dog must be moved into the corresponding number of classes as were at the lower grade. If there are fewer or no classes available for the next grade the competitor will be offered a refund of the relevant entry fees.
26. Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the Judges may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to the Royal Kennel Club.
27. In the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the club/society will refund fees, less reasonably incurred expenses. If the show processor has the provisions to do so, competitors will be refunded in the manner in which they entered the show, but in any event the society will refund fees within 3 months of the show date to all those who had entered and requested a refund within 1 month of the show date.
28. Except for mobility aids, nothing shall be carried in the hand while the dog is under test and food shall not be carried in the hand or given to a

dog whilst in the ring.

Competitors are prohibited from wearing bags or leads whilst under test.

29. No dogs' crates or boxes should be left near or between rings. Societies may, if they wish, designate areas where dogs' crates and boxes may be left in the vicinity of the rings.
30. No smoking or vaping is allowed within the ring area.
31. The handler must set their dog up to start within the ring. Dog and handler must enter the ring together and under no circumstances may a dog be left outside the ring off lead and recalled or sent to the handler in the ring.
32. Should the judge deem a re-run is required, any result and/or faults gained in the previous run must be discounted.
33. Separate entry forms must be completed by each owner and must be signed by the owner or his authorised agent in accordance with provisions specified thereon. Entry forms must be accompanied with the appropriate fees.
34. Free Passes - Not Applicable.
35. Competition of Dogs Suffering from Contagious or Infectious Disease – No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the Competition may compete. Competitors infringing the Regulation will be liable to be fined and/or dealt with under Kennel Club Rule A11.
36. It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class and running order. Competitors must run as close to their running order as possible. Failure to do so may be reported to the Kennel Club.
37. An exhibitor or competitor should ensure that contact details for any handler are available and must be provided upon request in any investigation of a breach of this regulation by such handler.
38. Animals In Event - No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the General Committee. However, at the discretion of the show society, a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show, with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times.
39. A pay on the day class will be held if time permits.
40. A practice ring may be available to dogs entered for competition at the show, if space allows. This ring must be supervised by a responsible adult with agility knowledge.
41. Welfare of Dogs. An owner (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog is met and should not knowingly put their dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.
The use of pinch collars, electric shock collars or prong collars is not permitted at any Agility show licensed by the Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue and within the precincts of the show.

Reserve judges will be appointed when and where required.

Photography and filming: The taking of photographs and films at the show for sale or reward is strictly prohibited except with the permission of the Organisers. There is no objection to the general public taking photographs or video film of general views of the show provided they are for private use only. Specific dogs may be photographed or filmed only with approval of the exhibitor.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOWGROUND

Directions from M6: Turn off on to the A7 at Carlisle and stay on the A7 until Hawick. At Hawick take the A698 for Kelso until it joins the A68. Turn left for Edinburgh until St Boswells. Turn immediately right on to the A699 through Maxton for Kelso. This road passes the Showground.

From the South on the A1: Take the A697 just after Morpeth for Coldstream, At Cornhill on Tweed take the B6350 (opposite the Collingwood Arms Hotel) for Wark. Stay on this road until Kelso. Turn right at the 'T' junction and then straight on at the next junction. The Showground is in front of you.

From the South on the A68: Pass through Jedburgh and at the fork take the A698 to Kelso. From Kelso follow the signs for Springwood Park Showground.

From the North: Take the A68 from Edinburgh until St Boswells. At St. Boswells take the 2nd road for Kelso, the A699 through Maxton, until you reach the Showground.
